### **GENERAL APPLICATION INFORMATION—REVISED 2012**

1. Applicant must be a Steilacoom High School senior eligible to graduate.
2. Applicant must meet admissions criteria to an accredited university/college, vocational/technical school, or community college.
3. Foreign exchange students who are not U.S. citizens are not eligible to apply.
4. Scholarship must be used for room and board, tuition, fees, or books only.
5. Awarded scholarships will be sent directly to the institution where the student is enrolled the first term following high school graduation.
6. A personal interview is required and will be scheduled with the applicant by the Scholarship Committee.
7. Applications must be typewritten or printed legibly in black ink.
8. If more space is required for information on any section, please include that information on the back of the same application sheet or on an additional plain white sheet of paper with the applicant's name and number of the section being continued.
9. Do not include any letters of recommendation, awards, resumes, etc., unless expressly requested by the specific scholarship.
10. Only complete applications submitted before the deadline below will be considered.
11. Please note that there is no guarantee that by submitting an application you will automatically be given a scholarship.

# Scholarship Detail and Eligibility Criteria Checklist

**1. Steilacoom Historical Education Foundation (SHEF) Scholarships –Various amounts, minimum is \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating Senior from Steilacoom High School (must have been enrolled the entire year)
2. GPA sufficient to enter college/university, technical/vocational school or community College
3. Good citizen, volunteer activities, extracurricular activities, and community involvement

**2. John Anderson Scholarships -- \$500.00 each**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Will be engineering, computer science, or math major and plan to attend a public college or trade school in Washington State. Students with a GPA between 2.5 and 3.2 will be given preference.

**OR**

2. Will be business or art major and plan to attend a public college or trade school in Washington State. Students with a GPA between 2.5 and 3.2 will be given preference.

**3. Linda and Gerry Evanson Scholarship -- \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School (must have been enrolled the entire academic year).
2. Must be accepted at and plan to attend Pacific Lutheran University

**5. The Lucas Family Scholarships -- \$500 each**

Eligibility Criteria check those that apply:

\_\_\_\_ SHS graduate entering Pierce College

**OR**

\_\_\_\_ SHS graduate entering a vocational or technical school

**AND**

\_\_\_\_ SHS graduate who has demonstrated outstanding leadership in student government. Student will have served the student body or other appropriate club in some capacity to show personal qualities such as organization, responsibility, fairness, and positive outcomes.

**6. Bill Rogers Annual Golf Scholarship -- \$500.00**

*The annual Bill Rogers scholarship recognizes an outstanding student-golfer and assists him or her in reaching desired career goals. The scholarship is named in honor of Bill Rogers, past golf coach at Steilacoom High School and an avid golfer.*

Eligibility Criteria

1. SHS graduating senior or student with a GPA of at least 3.0
2. Lettered in golf for a minimum of one year.
3. Carry a minimum of 10 quarter hours of academic credit.
4. Demonstrate positive character, loyalty, citizenship, intellectual capacity, leadership, and self-reliance.
5. Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from the golf coach.

**7. Bair Family Scholarship -- \$500.00**

*Given in memory of W. L. and Hattie Bair, Godfrey L. (Cub) Bair, and Mary Drew Bair, pioneers of Steilacoom, to honor their spirit of new ideas, new communities, adventure and hard work.*

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School (must have been the entire year).The recipient of this scholarship must live in the town limits of Steilacoom.
2. Your application needs to show leadership in your school or community.
3. Volunteerism is important, it demonstrates that you have a desire to make your school community or community a better place for everyone.

**8. SHEF Apple Squeeze Scholarship \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School
2. Planning to pursue a career in education

**9. Jaimie Garrett Scholarship for Volunteerism - \$750 minimum**

*This is a two year scholarship, with half of the award paid the first year, and the remaining half paid the second year.*

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School, must have been enrolled the entire year.
2. GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Must have been a volunteer for both school activities and the community.

**10. Courts / Jimenez Military Dependent Scholarship - \$1,000**

This is a merit based scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must be the child of an active duty or retired military member.
2. Applicant must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year degree-producing institution of higher learning
3. The focus of this scholarship is on the "whole person concept"
4. Criteria will include the applicant's participation and/or performance in a broad range of activities in grades 9-12, such as:
  - a. Minimum GPA of 3.2
  - b. Athletic participation/accomplishment (letters, team captain, etc.)
  - c. Extracurricular activities (band, debate, drama, etc.)
  - d. Student government
  - e. Scouting: Boy or Girl Scouts
  - f. Church participation
  - g. Work experience
  - h. Volunteer work

Although no one would be able to participate in all of the above mentioned activities, the intent is to reward the student who is well-rounded, showing acumen in academic, athletic, and other activities.

**11. Shellabarger Family Scholarship - \$500**

Eligibility Criteria

1. A graduating Senior from Steilacoom High School, enrolled the entire year.
2. GPA sufficient to enter college/university, technical/vocational school or community college.
3. Must have been a volunteer in school or community activities
4. Preference given to graduates who have financial need.

**12. Jonathan T Harris Scholarship -- \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Student of color
2. SHS graduate entering Pierce College, another community college, technical or vocational school.
3. Demonstrate positive character, loyalty, citizenship, intellectual capacity, leadership, and self-reliance.
4. Student has provided assistance/care to support individuals within community/home.

**13. Kiwanis Scholarships – Various amounts, minimum is \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Resident of Steilacoom School District.
2. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School (must have been enrolled the entire year).
3. High enough GPA to enter college/university, technical/vocational school or community college.
4. Show good citizenship, high standards of character and morality.
5. Community service as shown by actions and involvement of the graduate.
6. Participation in sports and/or extracurricular activities.
7. Preference will be given to graduates who are active in the Kiwanis-sponsored Key Club.
8. Consideration may be given to financial need.

**14. We Love Steilacoom Association Scholarship -- \$500.00**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating senior from Steilacoom High School (must have been enrolled the entire year).
2. Preference given to graduates entering vocational/technical school or community college.
3. Preference given to graduates who have financial need.
