

General Scholarship Criteria

for SHEF (Steilacoom Historical Education Foundation), Kiwanis, and We Love Steilacoom scholarships

1. Applicant must be a Steilacoom High School senior eligible to graduate.
2. Applicant must meet admissions criteria to an accredited university/college, vocational/technical school, or community college.
3. Foreign exchange students who are not U.S. citizens are not eligible to apply.
4. Scholarship must be used for room and board, tuition, fees, or books only.
5. Awarded scholarships will be sent directly to the institution where the student is enrolled the first term following high school graduation.
6. A personal interview is required and will be scheduled with the applicant by the Scholarship Committee.
7. Applications must be submitted through the online profile process.
8. Do not include any letters of recommendation, awards, resumes, etc., unless expressly requested by the specific scholarship.
9. Only complete applications submitted before the deadline below will be considered.
10. Please note that there is no guarantee that by submitting an application you will automatically be given a scholarship.

SHEF and local application deadline is April 1st.

Scholarships must be complete, including parent information, recommendations, additional questions or essays, and submitted online by this date.

Remember, once a scholarship is submitted, it cannot be updated.
